## AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 3, in line 32, strike "OCTOBER 1, 2001" and substitute "DECEMBER 1, 2000".

On page 4, in line 1, strike "OCTOBER 1, 2002" and substitute "<u>DECEMBER 1, 2001</u>"; strike in their entirety lines 5 through 12, inclusive; in line 13, strike "3." and substitute "<u>2.</u>"; strike

beginning with ", except" in line 13 down through "2000" in line 14 and substitute "this Act is an emergency measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety, has been passed by a yea or nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from the date it is enacted"; strike beginning with "for" in line 14 down through "years" in line 15 and substitute "until July 1, 2002"; and in the same line, strike "July 1, 2003" and substitute "June 30, 2002".
