AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 1293

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

In line 3, strike "a"; in line 4, strike "tidal"; in the same line, strike "license" and substitute "licenses"; in line 6, after "program;" insert "providing for the termination of this Act;"; and strike in their entirety lines 8 through 12, inclusive.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

Strike beginning with "the" in line 14 down through "2000" in line 27 and substitute "notwithstanding any provision of Title 4, Subtitle 7 of the Natural Resources Article, the Department shall issue an authorization for any of the fishing activities listed under § 4-701 of the Natural Resources Article to any person who has received a pardon after being incarcerated for a criminal offense, and who makes application and pays any applicable fees. Any authorization received by a person under this section shall be renewable annually in the same manner as any other authorization.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 2000. It shall remain effective for a period of 7 months and, at the end of December 31, 2000, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect".
