On page 6, in line 18, after "FACILITY" insert "OR EACH CUSTOMER WHO LEAVES A MOTOR VEHICLE FOR REPAIR OR STORAGE AT THE AUTOMOTIVE REPAIR FACILITY".

AMENDMENT NO. 6

On page 8, in line 11, after "JUDGMENT" insert "THAT MAY INCLUDE A FINE, COURT
