AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 515

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in the sponsor line, strike "and Love" and substitute "Love, Morhaim, Hammen, Hubbard, D. Davis, Frush, Hurson, Boutin, and Nathan-Pulliam"; in line 10, after "confidential;" insert "providing certain immunity;"; and in line 12, after "Assembly;" insert "providing for the termination of this Act;".

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 3, in line 17, after "PROGRAM" insert "REASONABLE"; and in the same line, after "ALL" insert "RELEVANT".

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 3, after line 34, insert:

"(C) A HEALTH CARE PROVIDER OR HEALTH CARE FACILITY IS NOT LIABLE FOR CIVIL DAMAGES OR SUBJECT TO ANY CRIMINAL OR DISCIPLINARY ACTION FOR GOOD FAITH EFFORTS MADE TO COMPLY WITH PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBTITLE."

AMENDMENT NO. 4

On page 4, in line 7, after "October 1, 2000." insert "It shall remain effective for a period of 3 years and, at the end of September 30, 2003, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.".
