AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL NO. 25

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in the sponsor line, strike "and Neall" and substitute "Neall, Green, Colburn, Haines, Forehand, and Mooney".

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 1, in line 9, after "Section" insert "639(a)"; and in the same line, after "641(a)" insert a comma.

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 1, after line 14, insert:

639.

(a) (1) The courts may suspend sentence generally or for a definite time, and may make such orders and impose such terms as to costs, recognizance for appearance, or matters relating to the residence or conduct of the convicts as may be deemed proper; and if the convict is a person under 18 years of age, the courts may also make such orders as to his detention in any care or custody as may be deemed proper.

(2) [In Charles County, St. Mary's County, and Calvert County, the] THE court may impose a sentence of confinement as a condition of probation."
