AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL NO. 136

(Third Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 9, after "Fund;" insert "altering the amount of the used tire recycling fee; altering the maximum amount of the Fund;"; in line 13, after "Fund;" insert "providing for the effective date of certain sections of this Act; providing for the termination of certain sections of this Act;"; in line 17, after "Section" insert "9-228 (g)(2), 9-274 (b),"; and in the same line, after "9-275" insert a comma.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, after line 5, insert:

"9-228.

(g) (2) The tire recycling fee:

(i) May not exceed [\$1.00] 40 CENTS per tire; and

(ii) Shall be established by the Board of Public Works.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Environment

9-274.

(b) (1) The Fund is limited to a maximum of [\$15,000,000] \$10,000,000.

(Over)

(2) If the sum of unallocated funds in the Fund and the projected fees for the next fiscal year exceeds [\$15,000,000,] \$10,000,000, the Board of Public Works shall adjust the fees for the next fiscal year on a pro rata basis so that the sum of unallocated and actual fees does not exceed [\$15,000,000] \$10,000,000.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Environment”.

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 4, after line 23, insert:

“SECTION 6. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Section 1 of this Act shall take effect July 1, 2000. It shall remain effective for a period of 4 years and, at the end of June 30, 2004, with no further action required by the General Assembly, Section 1 of this Act shall be abrogated and of no force and effect.

SECTION 7. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Section 2 of this Act shall take effect December 31, 2000.”; in lines 6, 8, and 24, respectively, strike “2.”, “3.”, and “4.”, respectively, and substitute “4.”, “5.”, and “8.”, respectively;

in line 24, after “That” insert “except as provided in Section 7 of this Act.”.
