AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 11, after "Governor" insert "<u>, under certain circumstances</u>,"; in line 13, after "purposes" insert "<u>and requiring a certain maintenance of effort</u>"; in line 14, after "beds" insert "<u>and</u>"; and in line 16, after "to" insert "<u>consider recommendations developed by a certain task force in developing the statewide protocol and to</u>".

On page 3, in line 13, after "OR" insert "IDENTIFIED AS".

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 6, in line 17, strike "<u>it</u>" and substitute "<u>: (a) It</u>"; in line 19, strike "<u>.</u> That the" and substitute "; and

(b) <u>The</u>";

in line 21, before "\$10 million" insert "<u>Up to</u>"; in line 25, before "\$5 million" insert "<u>Up to</u>"; and in line 27, before "\$1 million" insert "<u>Up to</u>"; and in line 33, after the period insert "<u>The funds expended in fiscal year 2002</u> for the purposes of Section 2 of this Act in excess of the funds appropriated in fiscal year 2001 shall be counted towards fulfilling the requirements of Section 1 of this Act, provided that the funds are included in the Governor's budget request for fiscal year 2002 and every year thereafter. The federal IV-E funds spent for the purposes of Section 1 of this Act as a result of a waiver agreement with the United States Department of Health and Human Services may not be counted towards fulfilling the requirements of Section 2 of this Act."

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 7, strike beginning with "this" in line 1 down through "Act" in line 4 and substitute "nothing in this Act may be interpreted to change the criteria currently used for determining when a child shall be removed from the custody of parents or other legal guardians found to have a substance abuse problem".
