AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 277

(Third Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 12, after "records;" insert "prohibiting a certain construction of this Act; encouraging counties and municipal corporations to conform certain practices to this Act;".

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, in line 23, strike "ENDEAVOR TO" and substitute ", TO THE GREATEST EXTENT PRACTICABLE,"; in line 25, after "INFORMATION" insert "FOR PERSONAL RECORDS"; and in line 26, after "PERSON" insert "IN INTEREST".

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 3, strike in their entirety lines 18 through 24, inclusive; in line 25, strike "(V)" and substitute "(III)"; strike in their entirety lines 28 through 31, inclusive; in line 32, strike "(VII)" and substitute "(IV)"; and in line 35, strike "(VIII)" and substitute "(V)".

On page 4, in line 4, strike "(5)(VIII)" and substitute "(5)(V)".

AMENDMENT NO. 4

On page 6, after line 4, insert:

"SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the provisions of this Act may not be construed to preempt or conflict with the provisions of Title 4, Subtitle 3 of the Health - General Article.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the General Assembly encourages counties and municipal corporations to review their privacy policies and data security safeguards and conform their practices to those set forth in § 10-624(c) of the State Government Article as enacted by Section 1 of this Act.";

and in line 5, strike "2." and substitute "4.".
