AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 8, before "and" insert "<u>requiring the local department of social services to</u> <u>reimburse a certain individual for certain costs;</u>"; in line 18, after "<u>(c)</u>" insert "<u>and (h)</u>"; and after line 21 insert:

"BY repealing and reenacting, without amendments,

<u>Article - Family Law</u> <u>Section 5-561(g)</u> <u>Annotated Code of Maryland</u> (1999 Replacement Volume and 1999 Supplement)".

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, after line 25, insert:

"(g) <u>A person who is required to have a criminal history records check under this Part VI</u> of this subtitle shall pay for:

(1) the mandatory processing fee required by the Federal Bureau of Investigation for a national criminal history records check;

(2) reasonable administrative costs to the Department, not to exceed 10% of the processing fee; and

(3) the fee authorized under Article 27, § 746(b)(8) of the Code for access to Maryland criminal history records.

(h) (1) An employer or other party may pay for the costs borne by the employee or

other individual under subsection (g) of this section.

(2) <u>The local department of social services shall reimburse:</u>

(I) an adult residing in a foster care home for the costs borne by the individual under subsection (g) of this section; AND

(II) <u>AN INDIVIDUAL DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (C)(4)(II) OF</u> <u>THIS SECTION FOR THE COSTS BORNE BY THE INDIVIDUAL UNDER SUBSECTION (G)</u> <u>OF THIS SECTION.</u>".
