## AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 18 (First Reading File Bill)

### AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in the sponsor line, after "Taylor," insert "<u>Barve</u>,"; in the sponsor line, strike "and Vallario" and substitute "<u>Vallario</u>, W. Baker, Bobo, Brown, Conway, D'Amato, DeCarlo, Doory, Finifter, Franchot, Giannetti, Goldwater, Griffith, Hammen, Hecht, Hubers, James, V. Jones, Klausmeier, Love, Mandel, Mitchell, Moe, Pendergrass, Petzold, Pitkin, Rosso, Sophocleus, Stern, Turner, and Weir"; in line 6, after "electronically;" insert "providing that an agreement to conduct a transaction electronically may not be contained in a standard form contract under certain circumstances; providing that an agreement to conduct a transaction electronically may not be inferred solely from certain facts;"; and in line 13, strike the second "to be" and substitute "from being".

On page 2, in line 2, after "acts;" insert "<u>requiring that certain standards adopted by units of</u> <u>State government be consistent with those specified in the State Information Technology Master</u> <u>Plan;</u>".

On page 9, in line 6, strike "AFTER" and substitute "AT THE TIME".

On page 14, in line 4, strike "§ 21-112(F)" and substitute "§ 21-111(F)".

### AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 5, after line 27, insert:

"(3) EXCEPT FOR A SEPARATE AND OPTIONAL AGREEMENT THE PRIMARY PURPOSE OF WHICH IS TO AUTHORIZE A TRANSACTION TO BE CONDUCTED BY ELECTRONIC MEANS, A PROVISION TO CONDUCT A TRANSACTION ELECTRONICALLY MAY NOT BE CONTAINED IN A STANDARD FORM CONTRACT UNLESS THAT PROVISION IS CONSPICUOUSLY DISPLAYED AND SEPARATELY

# (4) AN AGREEMENT TO CONDUCT A TRANSACTION ELECTRONICALLY MAY NOT BE INFERRED SOLELY FROM THE FACT THAT A PARTY HAS USED ELECTRONIC MEANS TO PAY AN ACCOUNT OR REGISTER A PURCHASE WARRANTY.

### (5) THIS SUBSECTION MAY NOT BE VARIED BY AGREEMENT.".

### AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 14, after line 17, insert:

# "(C) <u>STANDARDS ADOPTED BY UNITS OF STATE GOVERNMENT SHALL BE</u> <u>CONSISTENT WITH THOSE SPECIFIED IN THE STATE INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY</u> <u>MASTER PLAN.</u>".
