AMENDMENT NO. 1

In the Environmental Matters Committee Amendments (HB0068/550315/1), strike in its entirety, Amendment No.1.

On page 1 of the bill, in the sponsor line, strike "Delegate" and substitute "<u>Delegates</u>"; in the same line, after "Baker" insert ", <u>Walkup, Cryor, Stern, Boutin, Frush, Schisler, Owings, Oaks, Stull, Elliott, Guns, Hurson, Hubbard, Sher, and Crane</u>"; in line 2, strike "- Open Water"; strike beginning with "to" in line 3 down through "tributaries" in line 5 and substitute "; <u>prohibiting a person from dumping, depositing, or scattering certain material excavated or dredged from certain areas of the Chesapeake Bay into or onto the area known as Site 104"; in line 9, strike "5-1101(a)" and substitute "5-1101(a)(6) and 5-1102"; and strike in their entirety lines 12 through 16.</u>

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2 of the bill, after line 16, insert:

"<u>5-1101.</u>

- (a) (6) "Deep trough" means any region that:
- (i) <u>1.</u> <u>Is south of the Chesapeake Bay Bridge and north of a line extending westerly from Bloody Point; and</u>
 - [(ii)] 2. Has a depth that exceeds 60 feet; OR
- (II) IS WITHIN AN AREA OF THE CHESAPEAKE BAY KNOWN AS SITE 104.".
