AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 7, after "annually;" insert "<u>requiring the Department's Deputy Secretary of</u> <u>Health Care Financing to report to the Oversight Committee annually:</u>".

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, in line 11, strike "AND"; and in line 13, after "AGING" insert ";

(7) ONE REPRESENTATIVE OF THE HEALTH FACILITIES ASSOCIATION OF MARYLAND;

(8) <u>ONE REPRESENTATIVE OF THE MID-ATLANTIC NON-PROFIT</u> HEALTH AND HOUSING ASSOCIATION;

(9) ONE REPRESENTATIVE OF THE HOSPICE NETWORK OF MARYLAND;

(10) ONE REPRESENTATIVE OF THE MARYLAND HOSPITAL ASSOCIATION;

(11) ONE REPRESENTATIVE OF THE SERVICE EMPLOYEES INTERNATIONAL UNION; AND

(12) <u>TWO CONSUMER MEMBERS</u>".

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 2, in line 19, after the period insert:

in line 30, after "HOMES" insert "<u>, INCLUDING THE MEDICAID NURSING HOME</u> <u>REIMBURSEMENT SYSTEM</u>,"; and in line 32, strike "(E)" and substitute "<u>(F)</u>".

AMENDMENT NO. 4

On page 3, after line 2, insert:

"(G) (1) THE DEPARTMENT'S DEPUTY SECRETARY OF HEALTH CARE FINANCING SHALL SUBMIT A REPORT TO THE OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE ANNUALLY ON THE STATUS OF THE MEDICAID NURSING HOME REIMBURSEMENT SYSTEM, INCLUDING:

(I) ELEMENTS OF THE EXISTING METHODOLOGY THAT ARE NO LONGER RELEVANT;

(II) ELEMENTS OF THE EXISTING METHODOLOGY THAT CAN BE REVISED;

(III) THE APPROPRIATENESS OF REDESIGNING THE SYSTEM GIVEN CHANGING DEMOGRAPHICS OF THE TARGET POPULATION; AND

(IV) GENERAL FUND AND FEDERAL FUND SAVINGS FROM A SYSTEM REDESIGN THAT MAY BE REDIRECTED TO NURSING HOME STAFF DEVELOPMENT IN THE NURSING COST CENTER.

(2) <u>THE REPORT SHALL BE SUBMITTED ON MARCH 1 OF EACH</u> <u>YEAR.</u>";

in line 4, after "QUALITY" insert "<u>AND THE DEPUTY SECRETARY OF HEALTH CARE</u> <u>FINANCING</u>"; in lines 3 and 9, strike "(F)" and "(G)", respectively, and substitute "<u>(H) (1)</u>" and "<u>(I)</u>", respectively; and in line 5, after the period, insert:

"<u>(2)</u>".
