A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Natural Resources - Tidal Fish License - Transfer**

3 FOR the purpose of authorizing a person to transfer permanently a certain license or  
4 authorization to a niece or nephew; and generally relating to the transfer of a  
5 tidal fish license.

6 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,  
7 Article - Natural Resources  
8 Section 4-701(i)(2)  
9 Annotated Code of Maryland  
10 (1997 Replacement Volume and 1999 Supplement)

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 **Article - Natural Resources**

14 4-701.

15 (i) (2) The Department shall review and may approve the permanent  
16 transfer of a license or an authorization to a person who is the licensee's spouse,  
17 daughter, son, stepchild, grandchild, step grandchild, parent, sister, brother,  
18 grandparent, father-in-law, mother-in-law, son-in-law, daughter-in-law,  
19 sister-in-law, [or] brother-in-law, NIECE, OR NEPHEW, and only:

20 (i) If the licensee makes application to the Department requesting  
21 transfer and the transferee has paid the fee for the license or authorization; or

22 (ii) Upon death of the licensee, if the licensee had indicated that  
23 person's name on the license application on file with the Department.

24 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
25 October 1, 2000.
