- 11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 15 (i) (2) The Department shall review and may approve the permanent
- 16 transfer of a license or an authorization to a person who is the licensee's spouse,
- 17 daughter, son, stepchild, grandchild, step grandchild, parent, sister, brother,
- 18 grandparent, father-in-law, mother-in-law, son-in-law, daughter-in-law,
- 19 sister-in-law, [or] brother-in-law, NIECE, OR NEPHEW, and only:
- 20 (i) If the licensee makes application to the Department requesting
- 21 transfer and the transferee has paid the fee for the license or authorization; or
- 22 (ii) Upon death of the licensee, if the licensee had indicated that
- 23 person's name on the license application on file with the Department.
- 24 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 25 October 1, 2000.
