- 6 FOR the purpose of providing a waiver from tuition under certain circumstances for
- 7 the spouse of a police officer, a correctional officer, a volunteer or professional
- 8 firefighter, or an ambulance or rescue squad member who is killed in the line of
- 9 duty or the child of a police officer, a correctional officer, a volunteer or
- 10 professional firefighter, or an ambulance or rescue squad member who is killed
- in the performance of the officer's, firefighter's, or ambulance or rescue squad
- 12 member's duties, or who dies from a heart condition while employed as an
- officer, firefighter, or ambulance or rescue squad member if the spouse or child
- 14 enters the University System of Maryland, Morgan State University, St. Mary's
- 15 College of Maryland, or a State community college; defining certain terms;
- 16 requiring the spouse or child to meet the academic standards of the institution;
- 17 providing for a delayed effective date; and generally relating to a tuition waiver
- 18 for the spouse and children of certain deceased police officers, correctional
- 19 officers, volunteer or professional firefighters, and ambulance and rescue squad
- 20 members that a scholarship granted under the Edward T. Conroy Memorial
- 21 Scholarship Program may not be for less than a certain amount; and generally
