A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Anne Arundel County Board of Education - Selection Process**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring, in Anne Arundel County, the County Executive, with
4 the advice and consent of the County Council, to appoint members of the Anne
5 Arundel County Board of Education from a list of nominees submitted by the
6 School Board Nominating Convention of Anne Arundel County; and requiring
7 the School Board Nominating Convention to submit an additional list under
8 certain circumstances.

12 Annotated Code of Maryland
13 (1999 Replacement Volume)

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 **Article - Education**

17 3-110.

18 (a) The Anne Arundel County Board consists of 8 members who shall be
19 appointed as follows:

- 20 (1) 3 from the County at large;
- 21 (2) 1 each from Legislative Districts 31, 32, and 33;
- 22 (3) 1 from Legislative District 27B (Anne Arundel County Election
23 District 7; Precincts 1, 2, and 9 or District 30; and
- 24 (4) 1 student member.

1 (B) (1) EXCEPT FOR THE STUDENT MEMBER, THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE,
2 WITH THE ADVICE AND CONSENT OF THE COUNTY COUNCIL, SHALL APPOINT A
3 MEMBER OF THE COUNTY BOARD FROM A LIST OF NOMINEES FOR EACH POSITION
4 THAT IS SUBMITTED TO THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE BY THE SCHOOL BOARD
5 NOMINATING CONVENTION OF ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY.

6 (2) IF THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE AND COUNTY COUNCIL DO NOT AGREE
7 TO APPOINT A MEMBER TO THE COUNTY BOARD FROM THE LIST, THE SCHOOL
8 BOARD NOMINATING CONVENTION SHALL SUBMIT AN ADDITIONAL LIST OF
9 NOMINEES TO THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE.

10 [(b)] (C) (1) The student member shall:

11 (i) Be a regularly enrolled senior year student of good character
12 and in good standing in an Anne Arundel County public high school;

13 (ii) Be selected in the student's junior year by a method selected by
14 the Chesapeake Regional Association of Student Councils of Anne Arundel County;
15 AND

16 (iii) 1. Serve a term of 1 year; and

17 2. Continue to serve after graduation and until a successor is
18 appointed and qualifies.

19 (2) If a vacancy in the position of the student member occurs during the
20 term of the student member, the Chesapeake Regional Association of Student
21 Councils shall:

22 (i) Conduct a special election at its next general meeting; and

23 (ii) By utilizing the same method that it used to select the previous
24 student member of the Board, select another student member to fill the vacancy.

25 [(c)] (D) A Board member who does not maintain the residency qualification
26 shall be replaced as a member.

27 [(d)] (E) If the boundary line of a legislative district changes, an incumbent
28 member of the County Board who, because of the change, no longer resides in the
29 legislative district from which the member was appointed may complete the term.

30 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
31 July 1, 2000.
