- 16 (A) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY PROVISION OF LAW TO THE CONTRARY, A
- 17 PERSON MAY NOT MUTILATE, DEFACE, DESTROY, TRAMPLE, BURN, OR ATTEMPT TO
- 18 BURN A FLAG OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA ON ANY STATE-OWNED
- 19 PROPERTY.
- 20 (B) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES ANY PROVISION OF THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF
- 21 A MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$5,000
- 22 OR IMPRISONMENT NOT EXCEEDING 3 YEARS OR BOTH.
- 23 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 24 October 1, 2000.
