- 1 (B) A DELEGATE TO THE SCHOOL BOARD NOMINATING CONVENTION SHALL
- 2 VOTE FOR A NOMINEE FOR THE COUNCILMANIC DISTRICT IN WHICH BOTH THE
- 3 DELEGATE AND THE NOMINEE RESIDE AND ARE REGISTERED TO VOTE.
- 4 (C) THE SCHOOL BOARD NOMINATING CONVENTION MAY NOT REQUIRE THAT
- 5 A DELEGATE HAVE GROUP SPONSORSHIP.
- 6 (D) (1) THE SCHOOL BOARD NOMINATING CONVENTION SHALL SELECT FOR
- 7 EACH COUNCILMANIC DISTRICT AT LEAST TWO BUT NOT MORE THAN THREE
- 8 NOMINEES.
- 9 (2) A NOMINEE SHALL:
- 10 (I) MEET THE CRITERIA OF THE STATE ETHICS COMMISSION; AND
