14 AN EMPLOYER WHO TERMINATES AN EMPLOYEE FROM EMPLOYMENT FOR ANY 15 REASON SHALL PROVIDE THE EMPLOYEE WRITTEN NOTIFICATION STATING THAT 14 FINE EMPLOYEE IS TERMINATED AND THE REASON FOR THE TERMINATION.

16 THE EMPLOYEE IS TERMINATED AND THE REASON FOR THE TERMINATION.

17 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 18 October 1, 2000.
