3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting an individual from breast feeding a minor who is not

AN INDIVIDUAL MAY NOT BREAST FEED A MINOR WHO IS NOT A CHILD OF THE
INDIVIDUAL UNLESS A PARENT OF THE CHILD CONSENTS VERBALLY OR IN WRITING
TO THE BREAST FEEDING.

6 (A) AN INDIVIDUAL WHO BREAST FEEDS A MINOR WHO IS NOT A CHILD OF
7 THE INDIVIDUAL WITHOUT THE CONSENT OF A PARENT OF THE CHILD IS GUILTY OF
8 A MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$100
9 FOR THE FIRST OFFENSE AND NOT EXCEEDING \$250 FOR EACH SUBSEQUENT
10 OFFENSE.

(B) IN ADDITION TO THE PENALTY PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS
 SECTION, AN INDIVIDUAL CONVICTED UNDER THIS SUBTITLE MAY BE ORDERED BY
 THE COURT TO PAY RESTITUTION FOR MEDICAL EXPENSES.
