A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Food Service Facilities - Closing for Deficiencies - Advertisement**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene to
4 advertise the revocation or suspension of certain licenses of food service facilities
5 within a certain time after the revocation or suspension; and generally relating
6 to food establishments.

7 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article - Health - General**

15 21-315.

16 (A) The Department may suspend or revoke a license issued under this
17 subtitle if the licensee:

18 (1) violates or fails to meet the requirements of this subtitle or any
19 regulation adopted under this subtitle; or

20 (2) fraudulently or deceptively obtains a license.

21 (B) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL FILE A NOTICE FOR PUBLICATION IN A
22 NEWSPAPER OF GENERAL CIRCULATION IN THE STATE OF EACH REVOCATION OR
23 SUSPENSION OF A LICENSE ISSUED UNDER THIS SUBTITLE WITHIN 24 HOURS AFTER
24 THE REVOCATION OR SUSPENSION.

25 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
26 October 1, 2000.
