# 2 Comptroller - Cigarette Dealers - Inspections

- 3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the Comptroller to conduct certain inspections under
- 4 certain circumstances where cigarettes are stored under a license or permit
- 5 issued by the Comptroller; providing that evidence discovered during
- 6 inspections is admissible for certain purposes; providing for certain penalties;
- and generally relating to inspections of cigarettes by the Comptroller.

- 13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

### 15 Article - Business Regulation

16 16-223.

- 17 (A) (1) THE COMPTROLLER MAY, WITHOUT WARRANT AND AT ALL HOURS,
- 18 INSPECT AND SEARCH ANY BUILDING, VEHICLE, AND PREMISES IN WHICH ANY
- 19 CIGARETTES ARE AUTHORIZED TO BE KEPT, TRANSPORTED, OR SOLD UNDER A
- 20 LICENSE OR PERMIT ISSUED UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THIS TITLE.
- 21 (2) ANY EVIDENCE DISCOVERED DURING AN INSPECTION AUTHORIZED
- 22 UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL BE ADMISSIBLE IN A PROSECUTION FOR THE
- 23 VIOLATION OF THE PROVISIONS OF THIS TITLE OR ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW.
- 24 (B) A PERSON WHO FAILS TO COMPLY WITH THE PROVISIONS OF THIS
- 25 SECTION IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO A FINE
- 26 NOT EXCEEDING \$1,000 OR IMPRISONMENT NOT EXCEEDING 2 YEARS OR BOTH.

 $\,$  SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take 2 effect July 1, 2000.
