A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 State Personnel - Organ Donation Leave

- 3 FOR the purpose of providing that certain State employees may be entitled to organ
- 4 donation leave with pay; establishing the maximum number of days of organ
- donation leave that an employee may use to serve as a bone marrow donor and
- an organ donor; providing that an employee may use organ donation leave only
- 7 after obtaining approval from the employee's appointing authority; requiring
- 8 the Secretary of Budget and Management to adopt certain regulations;
- 9 providing for the application of this Act; and generally relating to organ
- donation leave for State employees.

- 16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 17 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 18 Article State Personnel and Pensions
- 19 9-1106.
- 20 (A) THIS SECTION APPLIES TO ALL EMPLOYEES, INCLUDING TEMPORARY
- 21 EMPLOYEES, OF ALL UNITS IN THE EXECUTIVE, JUDICIAL, AND LEGISLATIVE
- 22 BRANCHES OF STATE GOVERNMENT, INCLUDING ANY UNIT WITH AN INDEPENDENT
- 23 PERSONNEL SYSTEM.
- 24 (B) ON REOUEST, AN EMPLOYEE SUBJECT TO THIS SECTION MAY BE
- 25 ENTITLED TO ORGAN DONATION LEAVE WITH PAY.
- 26 (C) (1) AN EMPLOYEE MAY USE:
- 27 (I) UP TO 7 DAYS OF ORGAN DONATION LEAVE IN ANY 12-MONTH
- 28 PERIOD TO SERVE AS A BONE MARROW DONOR; AND

- $1 \hspace{1.5cm} \text{(II)} \hspace{1.5cm} \text{UP TO 30 DAYS OF ORGAN DONATION LEAVE IN ANY 12-MONTH 2 PERIOD TO SERVE AS AN ORGAN DONOR.}$
- 3 (2) AN EMPLOYEE MAY USE ORGAN DONATION LEAVE ONLY AFTER 4 OBTAINING APPROVAL FROM THE EMPLOYEE'S APPOINTING AUTHORITY.
- 5 (D) THE SECRETARY SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS GOVERNING ORGAN
- 6 DONATION LEAVE, INCLUDING REGULATIONS THAT ESTABLISH CONDITIONS AND
- 7 PROCEDURES FOR REQUESTING AND APPROVING LEAVE.
- 8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 9 October 1, 2000.
