- 11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 13 Article Public Utility Companies
- 14 7-510.
- 15 (f) A county [or municipal corporation] may not act as an aggregator unless
- 16 the Commission determines there is not sufficient competition within the boundaries
- 17 of the county [or municipal corporation].
- 18 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 19 June 1, 2000.
