- 11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

- 15 (a) (1) All individuals who are 5 years old or older and under 21 shall be 16 admitted free of charge to the public schools of this State.
- 17 (2) TO BE ADMITTED TO A KINDERGARTEN PROGRAM IN A PUBLIC
- 18 SCHOOL, AN INDIVIDUAL MUST BE AT LEAST 5 YEARS OLD ON OR BEFORE THE FIRST
- 19 DAY OF THE SCHOOL YEAR IN WHICH THE INDIVIDUAL ENROLLS.
- 20 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 21 July 1, 2000.
