SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

- 3 (A) A BEAUTY SUPPLY OUTLET <u>PERSON</u> MAY NOT SELL<del>, OFFER FOR SALE, OR</del>
- 4 POSSESS METHYL METHACRYLATE LIQUID MONOMER FOR ANY COSMETIC USE TO A
- 5 BEAUTY SALON, AS DEFINED IN § 5-101 OF THE BUSINESS OCCUPATIONS AND
