2 **Health - Sale or Possession of Methyl Methacrylate Liquid Monomer -**
3 **Prohibition**

4 FOR the purpose of prohibiting a beauty supply outlet from selling, offering for sale,
5 or possessing methyl methacrylate liquid monomer for certain uses; providing
6 for certain penalties; and generally relating to the sale, offering for sale, or
7 possession of methyl methacrylate liquid monomer.

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article - Health - General**

16 24-303.

17 (A) A BEAUTY SUPPLY OUTLET MAY NOT SELL, OFFER FOR SALE, OR POSSESS
18 METHYL METHACRYLATE LIQUID MONOMER FOR ANY COSMETIC USE.

19 (B) A PERSON THAT VIOLATES ANY PROVISION OF THIS SECTION OR ANY
20 REGULATION ADOPTED BY THE SECRETARY UNDER THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A
21 MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$1,000
22 FOR EACH VIOLATION.

1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
2 October 1, 2000.
