SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 (b) The annual license fee is \$100.
17 (c) The Board of License Commissioners may issue a caterer's license to a 18 holder of:

- 1 (2) A CLASS B RESTAURANT OR HOTEL (ON-SALE) BEER AND LIGHT 2 WINE LICENSE.
- 3 (d) A caterer's license issued under this section authorizes the holder to
- 4 provide alcoholic beverages at events that are held off the Class B restaurant or hotel
- 5 (on-sale) beer, wine and liquor license premises.
- 6 (e) The holder shall provide food as well as alcoholic beverages for 7 consumption at the catered event.
- 8 (f) A holder may exercise the privileges under this license only during the
- 9 hours and days that are permitted in this article for a Class B restaurant or hotel
- 10 (on-sale) beer, wine and liquor license.
- 11 (g) This section does not require a holder of an existing Class B (on-sale) beer,
- 12 wine and liquor license to have a caterer's license for catering on the premises that is
- 13 covered by the existing license.
- 14 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 15 October 1, 2000.
