- 19 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 20 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 23 THERE IS AN ADMINISTRATIVE COST ACCOUNT TO BE USED TO ADMINISTER
- 24 THE COMPLIANCE DIVISION OF THE COMPTROLLER'S OFFICE, CONSISTENT WITH
- 25 THE RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE COMPLIANCE DIVISION AS SET FORTH IN THE
- 26 ANNUAL BUDGET BILL.

- 2 (a) From the alcoholic beverage tax revenue, the Comptroller shall distribute
- 3 the amount necessary to administer the alcoholic beverage tax laws to [an] THE

- 5 (b) After making the distribution required under subsection (a) of this section,
- 6 the Comptroller shall distribute the remaining alcoholic beverage tax revenue to the
- 7 General Fund of the State.
