2 **Motor Vehicle Administration - Chesapeake Bay Commemorative License**
3 **Plate Program - Extension**

4 FOR the purpose of extending the termination date of the Chesapeake Bay
5 Commemorative License Plate Program until a certain date; and generally
6 relating to the Chesapeake Bay Commemorative License Plate Program.

18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
19 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

20 **Article - Transportation**

21 13-618.

22 (c) (1) An original or substitute commemorative plate may only be issued
23 under this section for a fixed period of 2 consecutive years after its initial issuance.

24 (2) The Administration may only issue 1 commemorative plate under
25 this section at any one time.

1 **Chapter 3 of the Acts of the First Special Session of 1992, as amended by**
2 **Chapter 91 of the Acts of 1994, Chapter 356 of the Acts of 1996, and Chapter**
3 **141 of the Acts of 1998**

4 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, notwithstanding the
5 provisions of § 13-618(c) of the Transportation Article, the Motor Vehicle
6 Administration shall extend the Chesapeake Bay Commemorative Plate Program
7 until July 1, [2000] 2002.

8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
9 June 1, 2000.
