HOUSE BILL 175

AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland 2 read as follows: **Article 27 - Crimes and Punishments** 3 4 442. 5 [No] SUBJECT TO SUBSECTION (E) OF THIS SECTION, NO regulated (c) 6 firearms dealer shall sell, rent, or transfer any regulated firearm until after seven 7 days shall have elapsed from the time an application to purchase or transfer shall 8 have been executed by the prospective purchaser or transferee, in triplicate, and the 9 original copy is forwarded by the prospective seller or transferor to the Secretary. [A] SUBJECT TO SUBSECTION (E) OF THIS SECTION, A person who is 10 (d) (1)11 not a regulated firearms dealer may not sell, rent, transfer, or purchase any regulated 12 firearm until after 7 days shall have elapsed from the time an application to purchase 13 or transfer shall have been executed by the prospective purchaser or transferee, in 14 triplicate, and the original copy is forwarded by a regulated firearms dealer to the 15 Secretary. 16 As an alternative to completing a secondary sale of a regulated (2)17 firearm through a regulated firearms dealer, the prospective seller or transferor and 18 the prospective purchaser or transferee may complete the transaction through a 19 designated law enforcement agency. 20 A person who makes an application to purchase, rent, or transfer a 21 regulated firearm by secondary sale shall pay a processing fee not to exceed \$20 to the 22 regulated firearms dealer.

- 24 REGULATED FIREARM WITHIN 1,000 FEET OF A CHILD CARE CENTER, ELEMENTARY
