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- 1 3. Has been an active member of the organization for at least 2 2 years immediately prior to the casino event. Any player's wager in a game at a casino event may not exceed (iv) 4 \$2 for each hand of cards or each roll of dice. A volunteer fire company or bona fide fraternal, civic, war 6 veterans', religious, amateur athletic, or charitable organization or corporation may 7 not hold a casino event unless it is held on premises owned, rented, or leased for the 8 regular use or occupancy by the company, organization, or corporation. 9 [Notwithstanding paragraph (3) of this subsection, on and after (4) 10 October 1, 1997, a person may not conduct a casino event in Anne Arundel County. 11 Any person, association, or corporation knowingly operating or 12 attempting to operate a gaming event in Anne Arundel County in violation of this 13 subsection shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be 14 subject to a fine not exceeding \$1,000 or imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 17 October 1, 2000.
