- 10 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 11 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 14 (S) ANY PERSON WHO IS CONVICTED OF A VIOLATION OF ANY OF THE
- 15 PROVISIONS OF § 16-808 OF THIS ARTICLE ("PERSONS INELIGIBLE TO DRIVE
- 16 COMMERCIAL MOTOR VEHICLES") IS SUBJECT TO:
- 17 (1) FOR A FIRST OFFENSE, A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$1,000 OR
- 18 IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 6 MONTHS OR BOTH;
- 19 (2) FOR A SECOND OFFENSE, A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$2,000 OR
- 20 IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 1 YEAR OR BOTH; AND
- 21 (3) FOR A THIRD OR SUBSEQUENT OFFENSE, A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN
- 22 \$3,000 OR IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 2 YEARS OR BOTH.
- 23 (T) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (F) OF THIS SECTION, ANY PERSON
- 24 WHO IS CONVICTED OF A VIOLATION OF ANY PROVISIONS OF § 16-807(A) OF THIS
- 25 ARTICLE ("COMMERCIAL DRIVER'S LICENSE REQUIREMENTS") OR § 16-815(E) OF THIS

- 1 (1) FOR A FIRST OFFENSE, A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$500 OR
- 2 IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 2 MONTHS OR BOTH;
- 3 (2) FOR A SECOND OFFENSE, A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$1,000 OR
- 4 IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 6 MONTHS OR BOTH; AND
- 5 (3) FOR A THIRD OR SUBSEQUENT OFFENSE, A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN
- 6 \$2,000 OR IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 1 YEAR OR BOTH.
- 7 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
