SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 (S) ANY PERSON WHO IS CONVICTED OF A VIOLATION OF ANY OF THE 15 PROVISIONS OF § 16-808 OF THIS ARTICLE ("PERSONS INELIGIBLE TO DRIVE 16 COMMERCIAL MOTOR VEHICLES") IS SUBJECT TO:	
17 (1) FOR A FIRST OFFENSE, A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$1,000 OR 18 IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 6 MONTHS OR BOTH;	
19 (2) FOR A SECOND OFFENSE, A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$2,000 OR 20 IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 1 YEAR OR BOTH; AND	

- 1 (3) FOR A THIRD OR SUBSEQUENT OFFENSE, A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN 2 \$3,000 OR IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 2 YEARS OR BOTH.

- 7 (1) FOR A FIRST OFFENSE, A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$500 OR 8 IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 2 MONTHS OR BOTH:
- 9 (2) FOR A SECOND OFFENSE, A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$1,000 OR 10 IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 6 MONTHS OR BOTH; AND
- 11 (3) FOR A THIRD OR SUBSEQUENT OFFENSE, A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN 12 \$2,000 OR IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 1 YEAR OR BOTH.
