A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Labor Law - Notice of Employees' Right to Organize**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring certain employers to keep posted conspicuously in each
4 place of employment a notice that advises employees of their rights to organize
5 and form a labor union.

6 BY adding to
7 Article - Labor and Employment
8 Section 3-708
9 Annotated Code of Maryland
10 (1999 Replacement Volume)

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 **Article - Labor and Employment**

14 3-708.

15 AN EMPLOYER WITH MORE THAN 10 EMPLOYEES SHALL KEEP POSTED
16 CONSPICUOUSLY IN EACH PLACE OF EMPLOYMENT A NOTICE THAT ADVISES
17 EMPLOYEES OF THEIR RIGHTS TO ORGANIZE AND FORM A LABOR UNION.

18 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
19 October 1, 2000.
