- 1 (B) "COMMISSION" MEANS THE TECHNOLOGY CENTER ADVISORY 2 COMMISSION.
- 3 (C) "FUND" MEANS THE TECHNOLOGY CENTER DEVELOPMENT FUND.

- 5 (A) THERE IS A TECHNOLOGY CENTER ADVISORY COMMISSION IN THE 6 DEPARTMENT.
- 7 (B) (1) THERE IS A TECHNOLOGY CENTER DEVELOPMENT FUND UNDER THE 8 COMMISSION.
- 9 (2) MONEYS FOR THE FUND SHALL BE INCLUDED IN THE BUDGET OF 10 THE DEPARTMENT.
