CHAPTER _____

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Anne Arundel County - Alcoholic Beverages - Class C Licenses**

3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting in Anne Arundel County certain special Class C
4 licenses from being issued for certain premises under certain conditions, unless
5 the Board of License Commissioners approves; increasing certain license fees;
6 and generally relating to the issuance of alcoholic beverages licenses in Anne
7 Arundel County.

8 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,
9 Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages
10 Section 7-101(a), (b)(2), and (d)(2)
11 Annotated Code of Maryland
12 (1998 Replacement Volume and 1999 Supplement)

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages**

16 7-101.

17 (a) (1) On approval by the board of license commissioners for that
18 jurisdiction, if any, of a proper application, made on forms prescribed by the State
19 Comptroller, signed and sworn to, the license issuing authority may grant the types of
20 special licenses for the periods and at the fees specified in this section.

21 (2) For an application for a statewide license, the Comptroller may grant
22 the license.

1 (3) (I) In Anne Arundel County, the provisions of §§ 10-103(b) and
2 10-202 of this article and § 10-501 of the State Government Article do not apply to an
3 applicant for a special Class C beer license, special Class C beer and wine license, or
4 special Class C beer, wine, and liquor license for a period not to exceed 7 consecutive
5 days from the effective date of the license.

6 (II) UNLESS THE BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS FOR ANNE
7 ARUNDEL COUNTY APPROVES, A SPECIAL CLASS C BEER LICENSE, SPECIAL CLASS C
8 BEER AND WINE LICENSE, OR SPECIAL CLASS C BEER, WINE AND LIQUOR LICENSE
9 MAY NOT BE ISSUED FOR A PREMISES IF ANY ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES LICENSE FOR
10 THE PREMISES PREVIOUSLY HAS BEEN DENIED, SUSPENDED, OR REVOKED.

11 (b) (2) In Anne Arundel County:

12 (i) The fee is [\$10] \$25 per day; and

13 (ii) The provisions of §§ 10-103(b) and 10-202 of this article and §
14 10-501 of the State Government Article do not apply to an applicant for either the
15 special Class C beer license or the special Class C beer and wine license.

16 (d) (2) In Anne Arundel County:

17 (i) A special beer, wine and liquor license, Class C licensee may
18 purchase beer from a wholesaler;

19 (ii) The fee is [\$25] \$50 per day; and

20 (iii) The provisions of §§ 10-103(b) and 10-202 of this article and §
21 10-501 of the State Government Article do not apply to an applicant for the license.

22 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
23 October 1, 2000.
