2 Election Law - Deadlines for Filing Certificates of Candidacy - Extensions

- 3 FOR the purpose of extending the time period in which a certificate of candidacy may
- 4 be filed under the State election law for certain primary contests if an
- 5 incumbent elected official dies within a prescribed time period prior to a certain
- 6 deadline; extending the time period in which a certificate of candidacy may be
- 7 filed in certain primary contests when an incumbent elected official files a
- 8 certificate of withdrawal after the deadline for filing of a certificate of
- 9 candidacy; providing that a certificate of withdrawal may not be filed after a
- specified date in certain contests; and generally relating to the extension of
- certain filing deadlines under the State election law where an incumbent
- officeholder dies or withdraws during specified time periods.

- 23 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 24 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 25 Article 33 Election Code
- 26 5-302.
- 27 (a) A certificate of candidacy shall be filed under oath on the prescribed form.

- 1 (b) The certificate of candidacy shall be filed with the State Board if the 2 candidacy is for: 3 (1) An office to be voted upon by the voters of the entire State; 4 The General Assembly of Maryland; (2) 5 Representative in Congress; (3) 6 (4) The office of judge of the circuit court for a county; or 7 An office of elected delegates to a presidential national convention (5) 8 provided for under Title 8, Subtitle 5 of this article.
- 9 (c) If the candidacy is for an office other than an office described in subsection 10 (b) of this section, the certificate of candidacy shall be filed with the local board of the 11 applicable county.
- 12 5-303.
- 13 (a) Except as [provided in subsections (b) and (c) of] OTHERWISE PROVIDED 14 IN this section, a certificate of candidacy shall be filed as follows:
- 15 (1) For candidates for offices other than delegate to the Democratic 16 National Convention, not later than 9 p.m. on the Monday that is 10 weeks or 70 days
- 17 before the day on which the primary election will be held; and
- 18 (2) For candidates for delegate to the Democratic National Convention, 19 between 9 a.m. on the first regular business day of the year in which the President of
- 20 the United States is elected and 5 p.m. on the day that is 1 week later than that day.
- 21 (b) A certificate of candidacy for an office to be filled by a special election
- 22 under this article shall be received and filed in the office of the appropriate board not
- 23 later than 5 p.m. on the Monday that is 3 weeks or 21 days prior to the date for the
- 24 special primary election specified by the Governor in the proclamation for the special
- 25 primary election.
- 26 (c) The certificate of candidacy for the election of a write-in candidate shall be 27 filed by the earlier of:
- 28 (1) 7 days after a total expenditure of at least \$51 is made to promote the 29 candidacy by the candidate or a political committee authorized by the candidate; or
- 30 (2) 5 p.m. on the Wednesday preceding the day of the election for which 31 the certificate is filed.
- 32 (D) IF AN INCUMBENT ELECTED OFFICIAL DIES WITHIN 7 DAYS PRIOR TO THE
- 33 DEADLINE FOR THE FILING OF A CERTIFICATE OF CANDIDACY UNDER SUBSECTION
- 34 (A)(1) OF THIS SECTION, THE APPROPRIATE BOARD SHALL CONTINUE TO ACCEPT
- 35 CERTIFICATES OF CANDIDACY FOR THAT OFFICE UNTIL THE CLOSE OF BUSINESS ON
- 36 THE FINAL DAY ON WHICH A CERTIFICATE OF DESIGNATION MAY BE FILED UNDER §

- 1 5-901(E) OF THIS TITLE, WHETHER OR NOT THE INCUMBENT FILED A CERTIFICATE 2 OF CANDIDACY FOR REELECTION.
- 3 (E) IF, AFTER THE DEADLINE FOR FILING A CERTIFICATE OF CANDIDACY
- 4 UNDER SUBSECTION (A)(1) OF THIS SECTION, AN INCUMBENT ELECTED OFFICIAL
- 5 FILES A CERTIFICATE OF WITHDRAWAL UNDER § 5-502 OF THIS TITLE, UNTIL THE
- 6 CLOSE OF BUSINESS ON THE FINAL DAY ON WHICH A CERTIFICATE OF DESIGNATION
- 7 MAY BE FILED UNDER § 5-901(E) OF THIS TITLE, THE APPROPRIATE BOARD SHALL
- **8 CONTINUE TO ACCEPT:**
- 9 (1) CERTIFICATES OF CANDIDACY FOR THAT OFFICE; AND
- 10 (2) A CERTIFICATE OF WITHDRAWAL FROM ANY INDIVIDUAL WHO HAD 11 FILED A CERTIFICATE OF CANDIDACY FOR THAT OFFICE.

- 13 (a) (1) Subject to PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION AND § 5-402 of this
- 14 title, an individual who has filed a certificate of candidacy may withdraw the
- 15 candidacy by filing a certificate of withdrawal on the form prescribed by the State
- 16 Board within 10 days after the filing date established under § 5-303 of this title.
- 17 (2) IF THE STATE BOARD OR LOCAL BOARD CONTINUES TO ACCEPT
- 18 CERTIFICATES OF CANDIDACY FOR A CONTEST UNDER § 5-303(D) OR (E) OF THIS
- 19 TITLE, A CERTIFICATE OF WITHDRAWAL MAY NOT BE FILED FOR THAT CONTEST
- 20 AFTER THE CLOSE OF BUSINESS ON THE FINAL DAY ON WHICH A CERTIFICATE OF
- 21 DESIGNATION MAY BE FILED UNDER § 5-901(E) OF THIS TITLE.
- 22 (b) An individual who has filed a certificate of candidacy for the special
- 23 election to fill a vacancy for representative in Congress may withdraw the certificate
- 24 on the prescribed form within 2 days after the filing date established in the
- 25 proclamation issued by the Governor.

- 27 (e) A central committee authorized to fill a vacancy in candidacy for an office
- 28 under this section shall file a certificate of designation of candidacy with the
- 29 appropriate board designated to receive the certificate of candidacy for that office by
- 30 the fifth day after the date on which a candidate may withdraw a certificate of
- 31 candidacy before the primary election.
- 32 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 33 October 1, 2000.
