1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Maryland Teacher Scholarships**

3 FOR the purpose of providing the award amount for the Maryland Teacher
4 Scholarship Program; authorizing recipients of certain State scholarships,
5 grants, or awards to be eligible for certain other State scholarships, grants, or
6 awards; and generally relating to the Maryland teacher scholarships.

17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
18 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Education2 18-303.

3 (a) [Except for an economic development student assistance grant awarded
4 under § 18-701 of this title, a Distinguished Scholar Award under § 18-1101 of this
5 title, and a Maryland Science and Technology Scholarship awarded under § 18-2001
6 of this title, the] THE recipient of an Educational Excellence Award may not hold any
7 other scholarship awarded under this title EXCEPT FOR:

8 (1) AN ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT STUDENT ASSISTANCE GRANT
9 AWARDED UNDER § 18-701 OF THIS TITLE;

10 (2) A DISTINGUISHED SCHOLAR AWARD UNDER § 18-1101 OF THIS TITLE;

11 (3) A MARYLAND SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY SCHOLARSHIP AWARDED
12 UNDER § 18-2001 OF THIS TITLE;

13 (4) A MARYLAND TEACHER SCHOLARSHIP AWARDED UNDER § 18-2202
14 OF THIS TITLE; AND

15 (5) A MARYLAND HOPE SCHOLARSHIP AWARDED UNDER § 18-2302 OF
16 THIS TITLE.

17 18-2202.

18 There is a program of Maryland teacher scholarships that are awarded under
19 this subtitle for students who pledge to work as public elementary and secondary
20 school teachers in this State upon completion of their studies.

21 18-2205.

22 The annual scholarship award shall be in the amount of [\$1,000] \$2,000 for a
23 student enrolled at a 2-year eligible institution or [\$3,000] \$5,000 for a student
24 enrolled in a 4-year eligible institution.

25 18-2208.

26 Except for AN EDUCATIONAL EXCELLENCE AWARD UNDER § 18-301 OF THIS
27 TITLE OR a distinguished scholar award under § 18-1101 of this [article] TITLE, the
28 recipient of a Maryland teacher scholarship may not hold any other scholarship
29 awarded under this title.

30 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
31 October 1, 2000.
