22 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, SUBJECT TO § 2-1246 OF

23 THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, the Maryland Horse Industry Board shall report

24 to the Senate Finance Committee [and], the Senate Budget and Taxation Committee,

25 the House Ways and Means Committee, and the House Appropriations Committee

26 THE HOUSE WAYS AND MEANS COMMITTEE, AND THE HOUSE APPROPRIATIONS

27 <u>COMMITTEE</u> by September 30, 2001 regarding:

28 (1) the activities, revenues, and expenditures supported by this Act;

29 (2) ANY ADDITIONAL STAFF NEEDS FOR THE NEW FUNCTIONS OF THE30 BOARD OR CHANGES IN LICENSING AND INSPECTIONS;

(3) THE BOARD'S REVIEW OF AND PROPOSED CHANGES TO THE
 STRUCTURE OF ITS FEES TO COVER THE BOARD'S REGULATORY EXPENSES; AND

(4) A LONG-TERM FINANCING MECHANISM FOR THE BOARD THAT
 WOULD PROVIDE FOR ALL COMPONENTS OF THE HORSE INDUSTRY TO SUPPORT THE
 EXPANDED FUNCTIONS OF THE BOARD.

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- 1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 2 October 1, 2000.
