18 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

- 6 (a) Whoever harbors any fugitive, so as to prevent his discovery and arrest, 7 after notice or knowledge of the fact that a VALID felony warrant has been issued for 8 the apprehension of that fugitive, and after notice that harboring that fugitive is a 9 punishable offense, is guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be fined not more than 10 \$1,000 or imprisoned not more than one year, or both.
- 11 (b) Whoever knowingly harbors a fugitive who is avoiding prosecution, 12 custody, or confinement after conviction of a felony is guilty of a misdemeanor and 13 shall be fined not more than \$1,000 or imprisoned not more than 1 year, or both.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 16 October 1, 2000.

This section does not apply when the warrant is for a traffic offense.
