BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 13 14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 15 **Article - Insurance** 16 10-128.1. 17 EACH AGENT OR BROKER: SHALL MAINTAIN RECORDS OF THE AGENT'S OR BROKER'S 18 19 INSURANCE POLICIES FOR AT LEAST 3 YEARS AFTER THE CANCELLATION DATE OR 20 EXPIRATION DATE OF THE POLICIES; SHALL ALLOW THE COMMISSIONER TO EXAMINE THE RECORDS; AND 21 (2) MAY KEEP RECORDS IN PHOTOGRAPHIC, IMAGING, MICROFILM, 22 23 MICROFICHE, ELECTRONIC DATA PROCESSING, COMPUTER, OR FACSIMILE FORM.
