- 1 (2) THE LOCATION OF THE FINAL DISPOSITION AND TREATMENT OF
- 2 HUMAN REMAINS THAT ARE REMOVED FROM A BURIAL SITE IN ACCORDANCE WITH
- 3 THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION SHALL BE ENTERED INTO THE LOCAL BURIAL
- 4 SITES INVENTORY OR, IF NO LOCAL BURIAL SITES INVENTORY EXISTS, INTO

- 13 (a) Any person who wilfully destroys, mutilates, defaces, injures, or removes
- 14 any tomb, monument, gravestone, or other structure placed in any cemetery, or any
- 15 building, wall, fence, railing, or other work, for the use, protection, or ornamentation
- 16 of any cemetery in this State is guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be fined not more
- 17 than \$5,000, or imprisoned for not more than 3 years, or both.
- 18 (b) Any person who wilfully destroys, cuts, breaks, or removes any tree, plant,
- 19 or shrub in any cemetery in this State, or who is found guilty of indecent or disorderly
- 20 conduct within said limits, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and shall be fined not
- 21 more than \$500, or imprisoned for not more than 2 years, or both.
- 22 [(c) Nothing in this section shall be construed to prohibit the removal of the
- 23 remains of any human body, or of any monument, gravestone, or other marker from
- 24 an abandoned cemetery, provided that the prior consent in writing of the State's
- 25 Attorney of the county or of Baltimore City shall have been secured and provided
- 26 further that such remains, monuments, gravestone, or other marker is placed in an
- 27 accessible place in a permanent cemetery.]
- 28 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 29 October 1, 2000.
