A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Alcohol and Drug Abuse Administration - Substance Abuse Program -**  
3 **Repeal**

4 FOR the purpose of repealing the requirement for the Alcohol and Drug Abuse  
5 Administration to find a certain location for a certain substance abuse program;  
6 and generally relating to the Alcohol and Drug Abuse Administration.

7 BY repealing and reenacting, without amendments,  
8 Article - Health - General  
9 Section 8-101(a) and (b)  
10 Annotated Code of Maryland  
11 (1994 Replacement Volume and 1999 Supplement)

12 BY repealing  
13 Article - Health - General  
14 Section 8-901 and the subtitle designation "Subtitle 9. Prohibited Acts;  
15 Penalties"  
16 Annotated Code of Maryland  
17 (1994 Replacement Volume and 1999 Supplement)

18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
19 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

20 **Article - Health - General**

21 8-101.

22 (a) In this title the following words have the meanings indicated.

23 (b) "Administration" means the Alcohol and Drug Abuse Administration.

1 [Subtitle 9. Prohibited Acts; Penalties.]

2 [8-901.

3 The Administration shall find an appropriate berth in an area that is safe for  
4 public access for a substance abuse program known as the U.S.S. Sanctuary.]

5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
6 October 1, 2000.
