A BILL ENTITLED

Education - Required Number of School Days

- 3 FOR the purpose of altering provisions of law mandating a certain minimum number
- 4 of days that public schools shall be open; specifying that a day on which schools
- 5 are closed during a state of emergency shall be credited against the required
- 6 number of days; and making this Act an emergency measure.

7 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

- 8 MARYLAND, That a day on which the public schools of a county are closed during a
- 9 state of emergency declared by the Governor shall be credited against the 180-day
- $10\,$ requirement in \S 7-103(a) of the Education Article, and the number of required school
- 11 days for that county shall be reduced accordingly.

12 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an

- 13 emergency measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health
- 14 and safety, has been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the
- 15 members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take
- 16 effect from the date it is enacted.
