- 3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting a person from constructing or blasting in the Potomac
- 4 River under certain circumstances; prohibiting the Secretary of the
- 5 Environment from issuing a waterway construction permit to construct a water
- 6 intake pipe in the Potomac River unless certain circumstances exist; making
- 7 provisions of this Act severable; providing for the legislative intent of this Act;
- 8 defining a certain term; and generally relating to the protection of the Potomac

- 16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 17 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 18 Article Environment
- 19 SUBTITLE 12A. POTOMAC RIVER PROTECTION ACT.
- 20 5-12A-01.
- 21 IN THIS SUBTITLE, "MGD" MEANS MILLION OF GALLONS OF WATER PER DAY.

- 2 THE PURPOSE OF THIS SUBTITLE IS TO:
- 3 (1) ASSIST THE PEOPLE OF MARYLAND IN OBTAINING THE PROTECTION
- 4 AND ENHANCEMENT OF THE POTOMAC RIVER IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE
- 5 OBJECTIVES OF ITS AMERICAN HERITAGE RIVER DESIGNATION; AND
- 6 (2) PRESERVE THE POTOMAC RIVER FOR FUTURE GENERATIONS.

- 8 (A) UNTIL STUDIES CONCERNING THE POTOMAC RIVER AND WATER
- 9 RESOURCES IN THE WASHINGTON METROPOLITAN AREA ARE COMPLETED AND
- 10 SUBMITTED TO THE GOVERNOR AND GENERAL ASSEMBLY, A PERSON MAY NOT:
- 11 (1) CONSTRUCT A WATER INTAKE STRUCTURE IN THE POTOMAC RIVER
- 12 WITH THE CAPACITY TO WITHDRAW MORE THAN 50 MGD;
- 13 (2) BLAST THE POTOMAC RIVERBED FOR A WATER INTAKE STRUCTURE;

- 15 (3) CONSTRUCT AN INTAKE STRUCTURE UNLESS THE WATER INTAKE
- 16 STRUCTURE IS AT LEAST 30 INCHES BELOW THE WATER SURFACE AT THE RIVER'S
- 17 HISTORIC LOW FLOW.

- 19 THE SECRETARY MAY NOT GRANT A WATERWAY CONSTRUCTION PERMIT TO
- 20 ANY PERSON TO CONSTRUCT A WATER INTAKE PIPE IN THE POTOMAC RIVER
- 21 UNLESS:
- 22 (1) THE PIPE WILL BE USED AS AN ALTERNATIVE FOR A PIPE ALREADY
- 23 IN USE:
- 24 (2) THE PIPE CANNOT BE USED CONCURRENTLY WITH THE PIPE
- 25 ALREADY IN USE;
- 26 (3) THE PIPE DOES NOT HAVE THE PHYSICAL CAPACITY TO WITHDRAW
- 27 FROM THE POTOMAC RIVER AN AMOUNT OF WATER THAT EXCEEDS THE CAPACITY
- 28 OF THE INTAKE ALREADY IN USE; AND
- 29 (4) THE PIPE IS PLACED NOT LESS THAN 30 INCHES BELOW THE WATER
- 30 SURFACE AT THE RIVER'S HISTORIC LOW FLOW.
- 31 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That if any provision of this
- 32 Act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid for any
- 33 reason in a court of competent jurisdiction, the invalidity does not affect other
- 34 provisions or any other application of this Act which can be given effect without the
- 35 invalid provision or application, and for this purpose the provisions of this Act are
- 36 declared severable.

- SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 2 June 1, 2000.
