This subsection does not apply to licenses issued under § 7-101(k) of 4 this article for a dance or social event: 5 (i) Advertised as being "bring your own" (BYO); or Held on the premises of the licensee by a member or by a guest 6 (ii) 7 of a member of the club, fire department, or other organization which is licensed. 8 Paragraph (1) of this subsection does not apply in Howard County to (4) 9 dances, weddings, fundraisers, or other social events held in a hall that is rented from 10 and is located on the premises of a veterans organization which is licensed under this 11 article.
