## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

## Employees' and Teachers' Retirement and Pension Systems - Transfers of Service Credit

FOR the purpose of clarifying that transfers between a State employees' retirement or pension system and a State teachers' retirement or pension system are not subject to provisions of law concerning transfers between State and local retirement or pension systems under certain circumstances; clarifying that eligibility service for a member who has transferred between the Employees' Retirement System and the Teachers' Retirement System includes eligibility service recognized under the previous system; clarifying that eligibility service for a member who has transferred between the Employees' Pension System and the Teachers' Pension System includes eligibility service recognized under the previous system under certain circumstances; and generally relating to transfers of service credit for members who transfer between a State employees' retirement or pension system and a State teachers' retirement or pension system.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments, Article - State Personnel and Pensions Section 22-303, 23-304, and 37-201 Annotated Code of Maryland (1997 Replacement Volume and 1999 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
3 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## Article - State Personnel and Pensions

25 22-303.
26 Eligibility service for a member of the Employees' Retirement System or the 27 Teachers' Retirement System consists of service credit:

1 (2) transferred from a retirement or pension system under Title 37 of 2 this article or Title 31, Subtitle 1 of this article;

3 (3) for military service, as provided in Title 38 of this article; [and]
4 (4) purchased under this subtitle; AND
(5) THAT EQUALS, FOR A MEMBER WHO HAS TRANSFERRED BETWEEN 6 THE EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM AND THE TEACHERS' RETIREMENT SYSTEM, 7 THE MEMBER'S ELIGIBILITY SERVICE RECOGNIZED UNDER THE PREVIOUS SYSTEM 8 THROUGH THE DATE BEFORE THE MEMBER BECAME A MEMBER OF THE CURRENT 9 SYSTEM.

10 23-304.
11 A member is entitled to eligibility service that equals:
(2) for a member who has transferred to the Employees' Pension System 5 from the Employees' Retirement System or to the Teachers' Pension System from the 6 Teachers' Retirement System, the member's creditable service recognized under the 7 previous system through the date before the member became a member of the current 18 system; [and]
(1) each system is operated on an actuarial basis; and

9 (6) A TRANSFER BETWEEN THE EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM OF 0 THE STATE OF MARYLAND AND THE TEACHERS' RETIREMENT SYSTEM OF THE STATE OF MARYLAND;
(7) A TRANSFER BETWEEN THE EMPLOYEES' PENSION SYSTEM OF THE 3 STATE OF MARYLAND AND THE TEACHERS' PENSION SYSTEM OF THE STATE OF 24 MARYLAND IF THE MEMBER IS NOT SUBJECT TO THE CONTRIBUTORY PENSION
25 BENEFIT UNDER TITLE 23, SUBTITLE 2, PART II OF THIS ARTICLE IN THE PREVIOUS
26 AND CURRENT SYSTEM; OR

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 3 July 1, 2000.
