4 FOR the purpose of clarifying that transfers between a State employees' retirement or

- 5 pension system and a State teachers' retirement or pension system are not
- 6 subject to provisions of law concerning transfers between State and local
- 7 retirement or pension systems under certain circumstances; clarifying that
- 8 eligibility service for a member who has transferred between the Employees'
- 9 Retirement System and the Teachers' Retirement System includes eligibility
- 10 service recognized under the previous system; clarifying that eligibility service
- 11 for a member who has transferred between the Employees' Pension System and
- 12 the Teachers' Pension System includes eligibility service recognized under the
- 13 previous system under certain circumstances; and generally relating to
- 14 transfers of service credit for members who transfer between a State employees'
- 15 retirement or pension system and a State teachers' retirement or pension

22 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

23 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

2 (a) Subject to subsection (b) of this section, this title applies to transfers from 3 a State or local retirement or pension system to another State or local retirement or 4 pension system only if:

(1) each system is operated on an actuarial basis; and

6 (2) under each system contributions that are computed to be sufficient to 7 provide the reserves needed to cover the benefits payable on account of the system's 8 members are made during the employment of members.

a transfer to the Judges' Retirement System of the State of Maryland;

(2) a transfer to or from the Legislative Pension Plan of the State of
 Maryland except to the extent provided by the Joint Resolution submitted to the

MARYLAND IF THE MEMBER IS NOT SUBJECT TO THE CONTRIBUTORY PENSION
BENEFIT UNDER TITLE 23, SUBTITLE 2, PART II OF THIS ARTICLE IN THE PREVIOUS
AND CURRENT SYSTEM; OR

(8) A TRANSFER BETWEEN THE EMPLOYEES' PENSION SYSTEM OF THE
STATE OF MARYLAND AND THE TEACHERS' PENSION SYSTEM OF THE STATE OF
MARYLAND IF THE MEMBER IS SUBJECT TO THE CONTRIBUTORY PENSION BENEFIT
UNDER TITLE 23, SUBTITLE 2, PART II OF THIS ARTICLE IN THE PREVIOUS AND
CURRENT SYSTEM.
