1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Frederick County - Alcoholic Beverages - Cultural Arts Center License**

3 FOR the purpose of establishing in Frederick County a certain beer and wine license

4 for the Cultural Arts Center of Frederick County; specifying an annual license

5 fee; authorizing the licensee to store for sale and sell beer and wine to the public;

6 specifying the times in which the beer and wine may be consumed; requiring

7 that certain officers of Maryland Ensemble Theatre sign the application for the

8 license; and generally relating to a beer and wine license for the Cultural Arts

9 Center of Frederick County.

20 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

21 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

2 6-301.

3        (1)        (1)        The provisions of this subsection apply only in Frederick County.

4 (9) (I) THERE IS A SPECIAL CLASS C (CULTURAL ARTS CENTER)  
5 ON-SALE BEER AND WINE LICENSE.

6 (II) THE BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS OF FREDERICK  
7 COUNTY SHALL ISSUE THE LICENSE FOR THE CULTURAL ARTS CENTER OF  
8 FREDERICK COUNTY.

9 (III) THE ANNUAL LICENSE FEE IS \$100.

10 (IV) THE LICENSEE MAY STORE FOR SALE AND SELL BEER AND  
11 WINE TO THE PUBLIC.

12 (V) THE BEER AND WINE MAY BE CONSUMED ON THE PREMISES  
13 NOT EARLIER THAN 1 HOUR BEFORE AND NOT LATER THAN 1 HOUR AFTER:

14                    1.         A REGULAR PERFORMANCE; OR

15                                 2.           A SPECIAL FUND-RAISER PERFORMANCE EXCLUSIVELY  
16 FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE CULTURAL ARTS CENTER.

17 (VI) THE PRESIDENT AND TWO OTHER OFFICERS OF MARYLAND  
18 ENSEMBLE THEATRE SHALL SIGN THE APPLICATION FOR THE LICENSE FILED ON  
19 BEHALF OF THE CULTURAL ARTS CENTER.

20 (VII) TWO OF THE SIGNATORIES FROM MARYLAND ENSEMBLE  
21 THEATRE SHALL BE RESIDENTS OF FREDERICK COUNTY.

22 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
23 October 1, 2000.
